2. Interdisciplinary therapeutic Centre for the protection of children, youth and families - established on the model of the Polyclinic for the protection of children and youth of the City of Zagreb, conducts monitoring and implements standards of protection and best interests of the child

- Advocating for the organization and implementation of measures to protect traumatized, abused and neglected children, with the aim of establishing and implementing multidisciplinary diagnostics and team planning of the best possible treatment for each child and parents, with children at risk of abuse and neglect, and children and youth in contact with the law; in cooperation with related institutions in the best interest of the child and his / her well-being (school, kindergarten, Centre for Social Work, Centre for Mental Health; prosecution, police, homes, children's villages, etc.)
